"ICT - the connecting path of Danube and Balkan regions to the entire Europe"

Scientific session

The Plenary Meeting of CTIF-SEE, which will be held in Bucharest, Romania, in 11-12 September 2014 on the campus of the University POLITEHNICA of Bucharest under the high coordination of Prof. Ramjee Prasad (CTIF-Global), will have two scientific sessions:

- "ICT in Horizon 2020 framework" (Networking and Brainstorming Session) is an internal and closed session dedicated to all CTIF-SEE partners. This session aims at exchanging ideas and views for future projects and collaborations. The session will end with brainstorming discussions; the presentations of the interested partners could be extended and published in a scientific journal.
- "ICT - the connecting path of Danube and Balkan regions to the entire Europe" is dedicated to young researchers of CTIF-SEE members and invited collaborators (PhD students or PostDoc researchers). The young participants of this workshop have to be the first authors of their paper in which they will publish their significant scientific results.

For both sessions, each partner or invited participant will propose a paper in her/his areas of interest in the ICT or ICT-connected domains. Also, other topics of interest are accepted.

For the "ICT - the connecting path of Danube and Balkan regions to the entire Europe" session are invited young persons (by CTIF-SEE members representatives and the session organizers – 2-5 participants) and one participant from each CTIF-SEE member country as proposed by the CTIF-SEE representatives of each member country.

Paper Submission: Authors should follow the manuscript format of the Springer journal papers. Instructions for authors can be downloaded from:

A minimum of 10 pages are required for paper evaluation.

The accepted and presented papers of the public session, as well as the presentations of the brainstorming sessions will be extended (to a max 24 pages) and will be published in a scientific journal.
